

Sample Course Objectives

This would be the sample course objectives for a two hour course on “Implementing New OSHA Guidelines in Your Office”:

At the end of this course, participants should be able to:

- Be able to name the most frequently found hazards in dental offices and understand your responsibilities as an employer to your employees for a written hazard communication program, how to locate information in MSDS sheets on health effects and safe handling of chemicals, and what training may be required for employees.
- Understand how OSHA regulatory concerns on Bloodborne Pathogens are different from CDC's
- Explain chemical and biohazard labeling system used in work environment, and identify those hazards requiring Personal Protective Equipment, and know the categories of PPE covered by most recent standard and how to match the PPE with the hazards identified.
- Explain the procedure for spill clean-up
